Local Scholarships: (more local scholarships will roll in this winter and be due in the spring, please check back frequently)

- Beal City Knights of Columbus Scholarship **Drawing** – estimated at two \$800 scholarships for one boy graduate and one girl graduate. Application available in the guidance office. **Deadline April 20th!**
- Aggie of Excellence Scholarship Award – 3.0 minimum GPA. Goes to a student who exemplifies excellence academically, artistically, and athletically as well as upholds the six pillars of good character. Applications available in the guidance office. **Deadline April 13!**
- Beal City Education Association – 3.0 minimum GPA and must plan to attend 2 or more years of college or technical school. Applications available in the Guidance Office. **Deadline April 12th, 2012!**
- Isabella County Farm Bureau offers up to four scholarships to students pursuing an agricultural field of study, ranging from \$500-\$1,000. Applicant or Parent must be a current member of the Isabella County Farm Bureau. Applications available in the guidance office. **Deadline March 1st, 2012!**
