
#### **Rotary Student of the Month**

#### **Elementary Walking Program**

Two years ago the wellness team received a grant that allowed us to use software for 5 years to track students' steps in miles. We started a walking club. Several students this year are really enjoying this program and are walking miles during lunch and afternoon recess time. Katie Hull does a great job of setting this up at the beginning of every year, monitoring it throughout the year and handing out toe tags for every mile a student walks. Students proudly show these off to everyone while wearing their name tag swipe cards. Teri Cramlet is in charge of the day to day walks with the students. She encourages them and walks with them! Blue even joins students on the walking track. We are especially proud of the top 3 classes! Our Littlest group, Mrs. Schmidt's class, who are in second place are in hot pursuit of Mrs. Hull's class in first place but don't count out Mr. Bloniarczyk's class in 3rd!! Teri started this visual footprint wall so the students could see their progress.1 footprint= 5 miles! Students have walked a combined total of 633.75 miles so far. Keep walking little Aggies!
