

The BCEF is very happy to announce that we will be opening the computer labs to study for the SAT test again this year. We will post the dates on Mrs. Millerov's door and we will need the students to sign up so that we can make sure students will be there. If no one signs up to attend, then we are not going to ask the volunteers to come and open the computer lab. These are self-study sessions, but, it is so important to get ready for the SAT test!!!
