Sydney Soules Wins \$500 Prize in State Math Competition

Sydney Soules, a recent graduate of Beal City High School, earned 2nd place honors in the 2021 TrigStar math competition in the state of Michigan this past spring. The TrigStar Program is an annual high school mathematics competition sponsored by the National Society of Professional Surveyors and the Michigan Society of Professional Surveyors based on the practical applications of trigonometry. The program recognizes the best students from high schools throughout the nation.

The purposes of the TrigStar program are to promote the study of trigonometry in high school, promote excellence by honoring the individual students who have demonstrated superior skill among classmates at the high school level, to acquaint high school trigonometry students with the use and practical application of trigonometry in the surveying profession, and to build an awareness of surveying as a profession among mathematically-skilled high school students.

The competition is a timed exercise that involves the solving of trigonometry problems, including a real-life problem mirroring typical situations that professional surveyors encounter every day. The highest score in the least amount of time is considered the winner. Sydney's score of 100 points was tied for the highest score in the state, and with an incredible time of 27 minutes and 10 seconds, her time was 2nd fastest in the state.

Sydney earned a \$500 award for her achievement. This is Beal City's fifth scholarship win in the program and the third time a Beal City female student has placed in the state. Sydney is attending Central Michigan University this fall to study Exercise Science and plans to pursue a Doctorate in Physical Therapy. Jen Butkovich and her students would like to extend a special thank you to the National/Michigan Society of Professional Surveyors for this opportunity and to Jan Fokens for sponsoring the program and sharing his time with our Precalculus classes.

MDHHS/CDC Recommendations

Beal City Public Schools is working on our 2021-2022 school year plans. It is our hope to have final information out in our back to school Aggie Express at the start of August. At this point though we want to offer a quick update on the MDHHS/CDC recommendations that came out on June 25th. These recommendations (and these are only recommendations) came out just last week so we have not made any final decisions on these yet. You should know though, Beal City Public Schools has always gone with the least restrictive requirements possible. We see this no differently since these are just recommendations and not requirements. With that said, we will be gathering input from internal and external stakeholders on these recommendations over the next few weeks. We are also getting dates set for back to school events (like open houses and orientations), finalizing student schedules, and a host of other plans for the 2021-2022 school year to make it one of our best yet.
